DDPHE Suggested Steps if a COVID Positive Case is Reported

Onsite contact tracing by event coordinators

- 1. Notify attendees of potential exposure using attendee registration information (see sample below)
- 2. Direct attendees to <u>current quarantine guidance</u>, specifically the piece on "Do I need to quarantine if I have been vaccinated?" which recommends getting tested 3-5 days after exposure and wearing a mask until a negative result is received.
- **3.** Direct attendees to report positive test results or the development of symptoms consistent with COVID-19 to event coordinators and cooperate with local health department interviews and contact tracing.
- 4. Five or more cases is considered a reportable outbreak in Colorado. Report to DDPHE if you are you're notified of 5 or more cases. All reports can be sent to <u>DDPHEoutbreak@denvergov.org</u> and need only be a brief summary of the situation and location of your event. DDPHE will connect you with an epidemiologist or outbreak investigator for follow up. 5 or more case must complete the outbreak reporting form found <u>here</u>. Second, there is a <u>line list</u> which documents each case of COVID-19 in detail.

Post Event

1. DDPHE only needs to be notified if you learn of 5 or more cases post-event. See step 4 above.

We were notified today that # _____ attendees tested positive for COVID-19 after arriving in Denver. Prior to their diagnosis, members of these parties attended official events (list events attended). <u>Group</u> and the <u>(CVB or Hotel)</u> are in touch with each who report being ill and send our best wishes for a quick recovery.

Please remain mindful of COVID-19 symptoms and seek a test if you present symptoms. View List of local Denver Resources (list of testing locations & services) And while at (<u>name of conference</u>), please continue to follow COVID protocol required to attend our conference in order to protect yourself and your fellow attendees.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention offers this <u>guidance</u> if you are sick or caring for someone.

Please know that this information is being shared to keep you informed and aware as we all work together to prioritize our safety.
